700 MT of Bottom Ash from the Trombay Thermal Power plant was used as backfilling material at 145 KV Vikhroli GIS project.


This initiative will help us in achieving sustainability & waste management goals, paving the way for IGBC certification. Ash utilization also helps in conservation of scarce natural resources.
