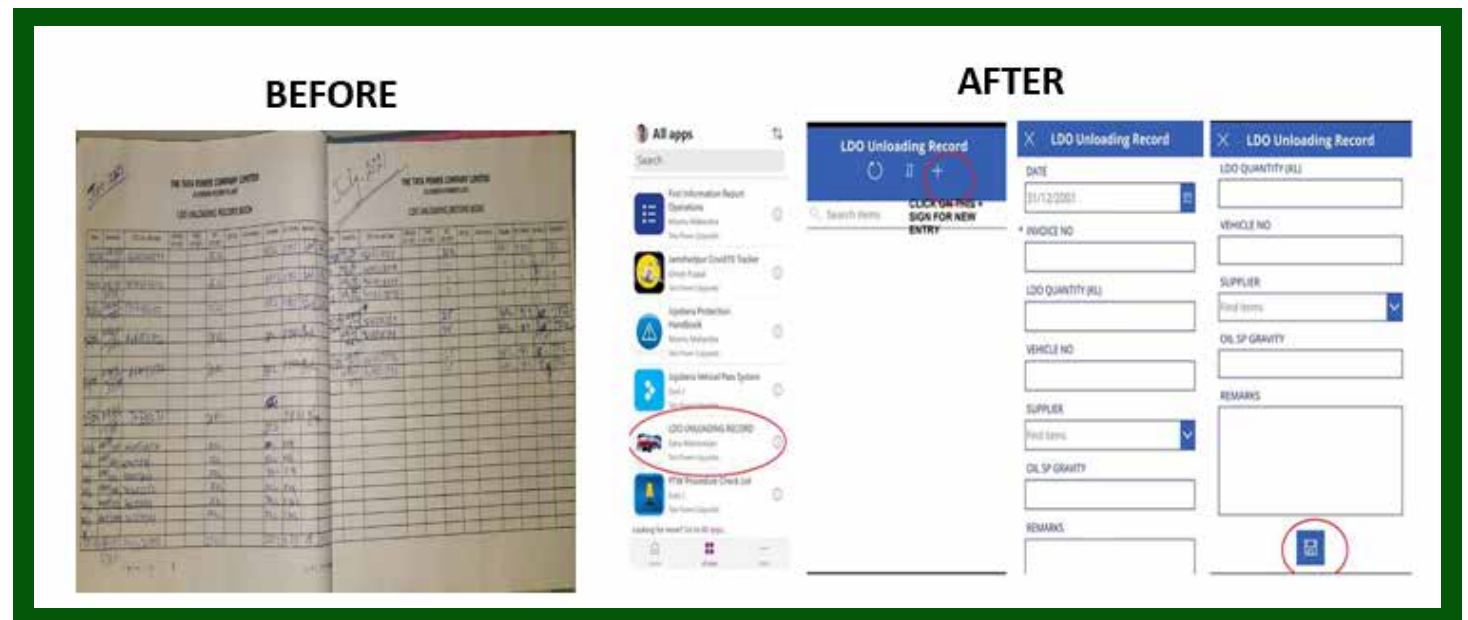
Digitalisation reduces paper usage in Jojobera!
