DGs are commonly used across offices for providing power backup to office cabins, although this contributes to high carbon emissions. Team Tata Power Solar tackled this severe challenge by setting up power backup through module and battery system.

Good Work!

Benefits:

- Research shows that 2.7kg of carbon gets emitted per liter of diesel consumed. The average carbon emission per day on an operational site amounts to more than 350kg (40KVA DG). If calculated for an entire project causes approx. 75 tons carbon emission. With this efficient solution, carbon emission can be significantly reduced.
- The raw materials used for the project, including solar panels, batteries, inverters are scrap from different project sites. Leading to a cost-efficient solution.

Paving way to a Greener Future!

As a major step in Tata Power's sustainable growth journey, Team Transmission Civil- Kalyan Circle installed a plastic paver block at Bhokarpada RSS. The Green Paver blocks are completely made from recycled plastic. The base material is High-density Composite Polymer (HDCP). Among different variants, load carrying capacity is 10 tons, 20 tons, and 40 tons. Unlike concrete paver blocks, this would be a sustainable choice, since plastic paver blocks do not generate heat and can also be further recycled to reduce carbon footprint. This would be the first-of-its-kind initiative in which Tata Power has used the paver block

completely made of recycled plastic.
