It was an abandoned Indie Breed puppy when our Security Guard had found it at the Gate of NTPC 50 MWp Solar Plant at Rajgarh , Madhya Pradesh . He was so cute. We decided to adopt him. I bring Food for him every day and as the days passed by, my bonding with the puppy increases with time. I have named him 'Sheru'.

Team rescued the lizard and successfully freed the lizard to its natural habitat outside the plant area (nearby hill beside the plant).

6. Team Trombay and Crow

On 13 Jan 2018 at 5:30 PM, We observed a crow was trapped in a kite string on the tree near the Hostel building in Tata Trombay colony. I rescued the crow along with Mr. Prem Prakash (security office Trombay) and colony security guard Mr. Dilip. The Crow's left wing was severely injured due to kite string and blood was oozing out. We gave first aid to the crow and handed it over to Animal welfare NGO.





7. Neemuch Solar Power Plant team and Sarus Crane

We have a small lake in front of our plant's [WREL-105 MW Neemuch Solar Power Plant] main gate. Recently a security guard found a SARUS CRANE trapped in muddy water and informed us in main control room. I and my colleague Mr Gautam Karelia rushed to the lake and rescued the SARUS CRANE from the muddy water. After that we took it in the plant and gave primary treatment and then we released it in the nearest forest.



8. Neemuch Plant and Dogs

We carried out rescue of a pregnant dog in the Walwhan Solar MP Limited 105 MW Neemuch Plant. We had found a pregnant dog near our plant's main gate. We decided to provide her with a safe place in which she could deliver and raise her puppies outside. We set her up with a comfy bed and prepared to wait for her to go into labor.

Just hours after we rescued her, she went into labor. All three of her babies were delivered 8 hours after she was rescued. She was holding out for a miracle, and that's exactly what she got... and just in time.

We all fell in love with the puppies. Within two weeks, the puppies started opening their eyes and showing the world their unique personalities. Now we are caring for three additional dogs.

Really it is an amazing experience of #ProtectAnimals.

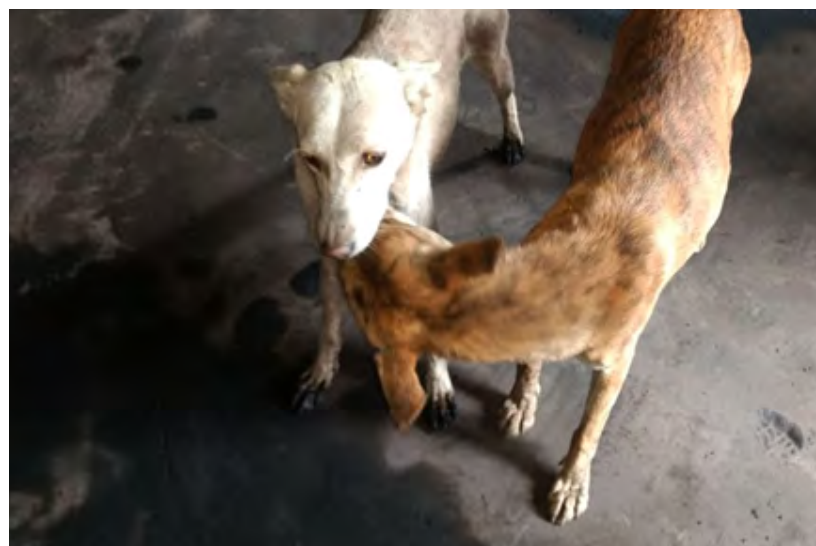


**9. J. Sebastian Kiran and Dexter**

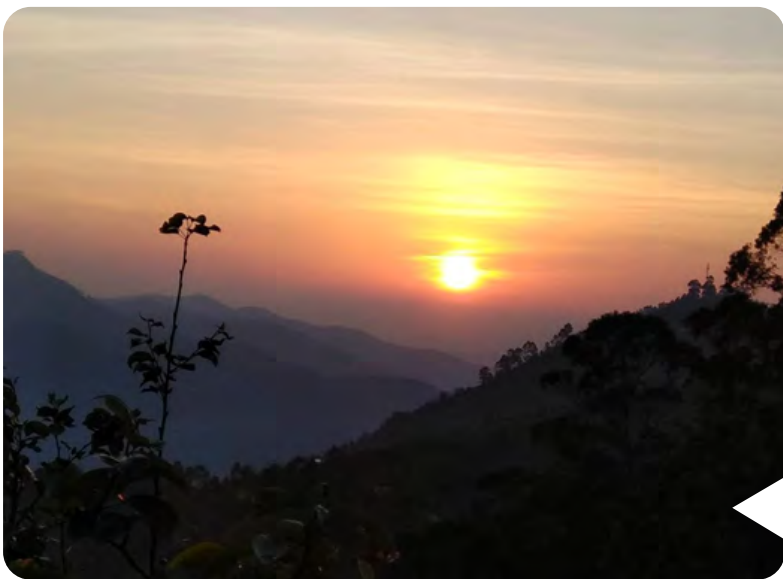
